Key Findings



1. Motivation and Expectations

- Most parents strongly agree that their children are motivated by school and that the school has high expectations for their children.

2. Holistic Development and Academic Standards

- There is a strong belief that the school's vision encourages holistic development and focuses on improving academic standards.

3. Curriculum and Physical Activity

- Parents generally agree that the curriculum is broad and that the school provides a wide range of physical activities.

4. Emotional and Social Support

- The majority of parents believe the school supports their children's emotional development and helps them work and play well with others.

5. Communication and Feedback

- Parents feel well-informed about their children's progress and find parent-teacher consultations useful.

6. Safety and Well-being

- There is confidence in the school's procedures for promoting positive behaviour and addressing bullying.

7. Inclusivity and Diversity

- KIPS is seen as having an inclusive ethos, valuing fairness and diversity.

8. Environmental and Social Responsibility

- Parents believe the school effectively promotes social responsibility and environmental awareness.

9. Digital Skills and Future Aspirations

- KIPS provides opportunities for children to develop digital skills and inspires them to aim high in terms of future careers.

10. Leadership and Community Engagement

- School leadership is viewed positively, with effective communication and a clear vision for the future.

Suggestions and Comments

- Some parents suggested more focus on challenging high-achieving students.
- There were requests for better communication regarding incidents at school.
- Parents appreciated the school's efforts in celebrating diversity and teaching about differences.
