Summary of Findings

Basic Information - Total Responses: 105 Total Questions: 55

General School Experience

- **Enjoyment and Safety:** Many pupils enjoy their lessons and feel happy and safe at school.
- **Teacher Support:** Pupils feel that their teachers encourage them to do their best and have high expectations for them.



Curriculum and Activities

- **Lesson Variety:** Pupils appreciate the mixture of lessons throughout the week, including literacy, maths, topic work, art, and PE.
- **Physical Activity:** There are ample opportunities for physical activity, such as PE, Daily Mile, and after-school activities.
- **Art and Music:** Pupils enjoy using various materials in art and design and have a good mixture of activities in music lessons.

Emotional and Social Development

- **Emotional Health:** The school helps pupils understand and manage their emotional health through programs like Mood Tracker and MyHappyMind.
- **Social Skills:** Pupils feel supported in working and playing with others and learning about different faiths and beliefs.

Behaviour and Wellbeing

- **Behaviour Encouragement:** Pupils are encouraged to make good choices about their physical and emotional wellbeing and to behave well.
- **Bullying Awareness:** Pupils understand what bullying behaviours are and know how to get help if needed.

- **Respect for Diversity:** The school helps pupils understand and respect differences and diversity. Pupils feel they are treated fairly and equally.
- **Shared Education:** Pupils enjoy working and playing with pupils from other schools as part of shared education classes.

Pupil Voice and Engagement

- **Self-Assessment:** Pupils often get to self-assess their own work and assess work with a partner.
- **Environmental Responsibility:** The school motivates pupils to make better environmental decisions and understand their responsibility to the environment.

Future Aspirations

- **Career Education:** The school inspires pupils to aim high in terms of their future career and progression pathways and educates them about future employment aspirations.
- **ICT Skills:** Pupils feel supported in developing their ICT skills and know how to stay safe and be responsible users of digital technology.

- **Play Equipment:** Several pupils suggested having more play equipment and green spaces in the playground.
