Top Ten Benefits of Reading Regularly at Home with a Parent/ Carer

1. Their vocabulary is larger and more extensive.
2. They perform better academically.
3. Their imagination can run wild.
4. Their creativity skills develop.
5. They develop empathy.
6. They gain a deeper understanding of their world.
7. Their concentration levels improve.
8. The adult and child bond improves.
9. Their cognitive development is supported.
10. Their social skills and interaction with others improve.
